Founded in 2013, Christine & Tony Lombardi began a passion project that honors a rich family history of wine, food, and tradition. The winery crafts small lots of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir from some of the finest vineyards in Sonoma County, where the Lombardi family has been since 1947.

THE VINEYARD

We are very excited to release our first single-vineyard Pinot Noir from the Martaella Vineyard. This estate vineyard is named in honor of the mothers of Joe Anderson and Mary Dewane, proprietors of Benovia Winery. The 58-acre property is in the heart of the Russian River Valley in an area known as the Laguna de Santa Rosa.

AROMATICS

The 2021 Pinot Noir reveals a deep ruby color, and vibrant raspberry, boysenberry, and baking spice aromas leap from the glass.

ON THE PALATE

This Russian River Valley Pinot Noir has a juicy mouthfeel supported by pomegranate and dark cherry, building through the mid-palate with fine grain tannins leading to a lingering and persistent juicy finish.
