Founded in 2013, Christine & Tony Lombardi began a passion project that honors a rich family history of wine, food, and tradition. The winery crafts small lots of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir from some of the finest vineyards in Sonoma County, where the Lombardi family has been since 1947.

AROMATICS

This alluring Pinot Noir reveals dark aromas of blackberry, black cherry, and ripe currants in the nose with a dust of cocoa.

ON THE PALATE

The 2021 Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir delivers dark black fruits that slowly melt into all areas of the mouth. There is focused acidity and fine dry tannins that carry the rich blackberry, anise, cedar, black licorice and mocha flavors toward the mid-palate, leading to a lingering juicy finish of black cherry and dried currants.
